There is a voice speaking.

That voice is sovereign.

That voice *alone* is sovereign.

That voice rules.

... not only heard, but heeded.

... not only obliged, but obeyed.

**God's voice is sovereign over all rulers.** (1-3)

☀ It overrules all **political** sovereignty. (1-3a)

☀ It overrules all **national** sovereignty. (3b)

## God's voice sovereign over all **persons**.

(4-10, 17-19)

- ☀ It overrules all personal **choice**. (5)
- ☀ It overrules all personal **objections**. (6-8)
- ☀ It overrules all personal **deficiencies**. (9)
- ☀ It overrules all personal **plans**. (10)

**God's voice is sovereign over all nations.**

(11-16)

☀ There is a **ripening** point. (11-12)

☀ There is a **tipping** point. (13-16)



Get **READY!** “dress yourself for work”

Get **UP!** “arise”

Get **GOING!** “say to them everything  
that I command you”
