"Blessed is the man who remains steadfast under trial, for when he has stood the test he will receive the crown of life, which God has promised to those who love him." (James 1:12)

18. We will shine forever to God's glory.

"... will shine like the sun in the kingdom of [our] Father." (Matthew 13:43)

19. Conformed fully to the image of Jesus.

"For those whom he foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son ..." (Romans 8:29)

20. God will wipe every tear.

"He will swallow up death forever; and the Lord GOD will wipe away tears from all faces, and the reproach of his people he will take away from all the earth, for the LORD has spoken." (Isaiah 25:8)

21. There will be no more death or pain.

"... death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning, nor crying, nor pain anymore, for the former things have passed away." (Revelation 21:4b)

22. We will experience "fullness of joy."

"You make known to me the path of life; in your presence there is fullness of joy; at your right hand are pleasures forevermore." (Psalm 16:11)

23. Invited to enter the joy of our Master.
